

Meet The Owners

The Barossa Valley has a rich history and we have a strong connection for us as our family have lived in the region for a few generations. I grew up in the Barossa, my parents were the licensee of the Light Hotel in Eudunda then the Barossa Hotel in Angaston and finally the Duke of Yorke hotel in Adelaide (from the 1950s to early 1970s). I attended Eudunda Area School, then Angaston Primary School then Nuriootpa High and finally Pultney Grammar School in Adelaide. While living at the Barossa Hotel in Angaston we owned a farm near Eden Valley called 'White Fields'. My wife Jan grew up in Adelaide and we met in the late 70's when we both worked at the Royal Adelaide Hospital (RAH), I was training as what was then known as a Surgical Instrument Maker and Jan was a nurse. We moved to Sydney in the late 80's were I continued my career and Jan continued nursing and we raised our two daughters.

We found this house we now call Whiterocks in Julius street Tanunda in 2015 and fell in love with the house and location. The house was built in 1935 we believe by a couple who also had a few other houses built in Julius street, if you look at the bricks you will notice distinctive marks derived from the bricks being hand stacked in layers with each layer spaced and angled to the lower row so as the bricks were fired a partial impression of the brick on top and below appears. Look at other houses in Julius street and you will see the same hand fired reddish bricks in about 4 other houses. We are reliably told that those houses were built by the same couple and our house was the last they built and lived in.

As you can see the house is beautifully built by quality builders of the period with glazed brick fire places, all different in most rooms. The external walls are uniquely designed with a finely pointed sandstone lower third then kiln fired red brick middle third and stucco top third with high pitched gable ends facing both street frontages. The front facing rooms all have unique and differently designed bay windows. The front street facing corner features a curved porch with columns. Internal high ceilings are set with dark timber trim and cornicing along with a dome in the entrance hall. All in all we think a quirky and charming design and decor.

Our intention is to preserve all the original features and ensuring the house's heritage value is preserved for future generations to enjoy.

No Smoking

Whiterocks is a NO SMOKING property. A \$300 cleaning fee applies should you smoke indoors.

Bedding

There are electric blankets on all beds and a spare blanket in the blanket box or wardrobe. The pillows on the beds are of different thickness and hardness for your comfort.

Air Conditioner

Fully ducted reverse cycle air conditioning is provided for your year round comfort. The control panel is located on the wall near the 'snug' room.

Septic Tank

All waste water is disposed of through the town Community Septic effluent system. There is a septic tank underground in the back lawn area which drains to the town community effluent system. Please do not flush sanitary napkins or any other items down the toilet, place them in the covered bin in the bathroom.

Bathrooms

For those colder winter months the bathroom has a heated floor which is programmed to come on in the morning and afternoon/evening. The floor heating controllers are programmed automatically, the controls are locked however pressing the button on the screen will show the current floor temperature.

Please **always** use the exhaust fan while showering.

SA Government mandated hot water tank regulations limit the maximum hot water tank size to 250 litres. We have installed the largest allowable hot water system of 250 litres. The hot water system is electrically heated overnight (off-peak tariff). There should be plenty of hot water for all guests showering needs.

Firewood

Only use the enclosed slow combustion Nectre fire box in the main lounge room. All other open fire places in other rooms are not to be used, the chimneys are deliberately closed off to minimise bird and insect ingress.

The slow combustion fire is set to go during winter months. There is more fire wood stacked under the carport. It is better to have a slow fire that radiates heat than a roaring fire where the heat disappears up the chimney and sucks cold air in from outside.

Please do not burn any other materials in the fire. The black firebox is very hot during use, please don't let anyone touch its hot surface to avoid burns. Please do not clean the ashes from the fire. We will clean it after your stay.

Laundry

A washer, dryer, iron and ironing board is available in the laundry. There is a clothes line on the back lawn near the laundry door. Please ONLY turn the clothes dryer control knob clockwise to set run time, turning it anticlockwise will damage it.

Barbeque

A Gas BBQ is available for your use. BBQ cooking utensils are in the kitchen in the bottom drawer under the benchtop microwave. Please clean it after each use. The BBQ grill plate and hot plate may be washed in the laundry tub. If the gas cylinder runs empty please call Peter on 0418 245858 to assist with a replacement 'swap and go' full cylinder.

Electricity Circuit Breakers or Earth Jeakage Breakers

In the event that one of the electricity circuits overload or there is a leakage to earth one of the Circuit Breakers will trip. The switchboard is located at the front left outside corner of the house. There is a battery torch located in the kitchen. If it immediately flicks back off again there is obviously something wrong. Try turning off and un-plugging appliances such as the toaster, kettle, iron and/or hair dryer.

If the Circuit Breaker keeps tripping please call Peter on 0418 245 858.

Emergency Situations

Smoke alarms are installed in the house. If they go off please advise others in the house that the alarm has sounded then evacuate BY THE FRONT DOOR onto the street. Call the appropriate emergency service listed below.
